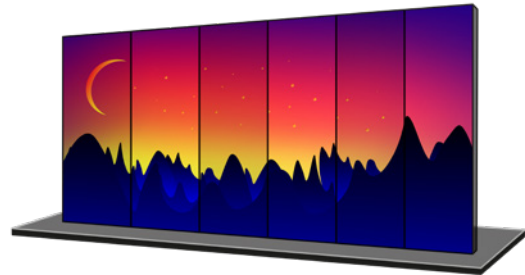
DOCUMENT SIZE

Please ensure that your artwork is supplied at the correct size or at a reduced scale to fit your final print area.

For example: 10%, 25%, 50%.

1200mm x 800mm at 50% would scale down to 600mm x 400mm.

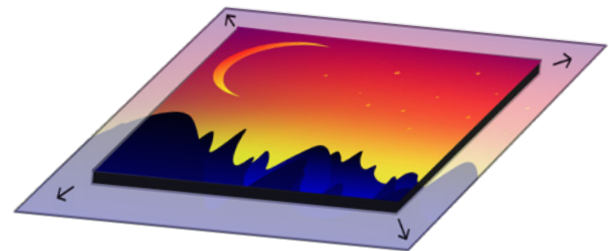
If your artwork is to be in multiple panels please do not tile or section it, this will be done by us to ensure the best finish and fit.



BLEED

Please ensure your artwork has 5mm bleed all all edges around your final print size and turn off the reg marks and slug lines. If your artwork is having wrapped edges you will need to include 25mm bleed. Canvas frames require 100mm of image bleed all round so the frames can be wrapped.

Your artwork may be returned by our studio if bleed is absent, alternatively an hourly rate will be charged for any amendments.

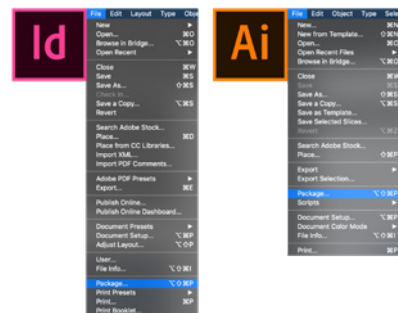


FILE FORMATS

Please use the 'package' menu to supply all fonts and images when using InDesign (indd) or Illustrator (ai) files as artwork. This ensures we have everything supplied to process your artwork.

Supplying printed visuals or screenshots with your artwork helps to make sure we are reproducing your artwork correctly.

High resolution PDF artwork must have fonts embedded or outlined.



RESOLUTION

The better quality artwork the better quality the print. If your artwork includes images please ensure that they are a minimum of 80dpi at final size. Low resolution images may result in pixelation.
